Plan ahead: UKVI (UK Visa and Immigration) guidelines for living costs in Bristol are approximately £1,023.00 per month. This must be held in a recognised bank account for at least 28 days before you apply for your Student visa. You face a visa refusal if your funds fall below the minimum required amount at any point during these 28 days.

5. **Arrange your travel and complete your arrival form.**
On certain dates during the enrolment period, we offer pick-up services from multiple UK airports to your student accommodation. It is important that we know when you will arrive and so we therefore ask all students to complete their arrival form, even if you will be organising your own travel arrangements. You will receive a link to the arrival form after you pay your deposit and when we send you your CAS (Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies). You will need to use the CAS to apply for your Visa.

Additional information on the Pre-Master's Programme

Programme Aims:

The University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's Programmes aim to equip international students with a range of subject-related knowledge, higher-level academic skills and advanced level English language capabilities, in order that they become independent, self-directed learners and achieve the necessary academic standards to progress to Master's study at UK Higher Education Institutions.

Characteristic Outcomes:

By the end of a University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's Programme, students are expected to have demonstrated achievement of a number of discipline-specific outcomes, as well as academic skills and English language abilities.

Characteristic graduate outcomes for the University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's Programmes include:

- 1) A systematic understanding and critical awareness of problems and new insights in the chosen subject area;
- 2) An ability to accurately deploy established techniques of analysis and enquiry within the discipline;
- 3) An ability to manage one's own learning, and to make use of scholarly reviews and primary sources;
- 4) An ability to understand and respond, using language effectively within the appropriate academic environment.

Typically, as a result of the University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's, students will be able to:

- 1) Apply the methods and techniques that they have learned to review, consolidate, extend and apply their knowledge and understanding, and to initiate and carry out projects;
- 2) Critically evaluate arguments, assumptions, concepts and data, to make judgements, and frame appropriate questions to achieve a solution to a problem;
- 3) Communicate information, ideas, problems and solutions to both specialist and non-specialist audiences;
- 4) Undertake further learning within UK Higher Education at Master's level.

Academic Subject Areas:

University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's Programmes prepare students for Master's-level study in a number of different subject areas. These include:

Business, Law, Social Sciences, Engineering

External and Internal Reference Points:

The University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's Programmes do not seek to replicate the subject knowledge to be gained from an undergraduate degree in a particular subject area, as students will have already studied an appropriate discipline at undergraduate level. However, the University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's is designed to equip students with a range of intellectual and transferable learning outcomes relevant to their chosen discipline in line with the Kaplan International Qualifications Framework and, where appropriate, QAA Master's-level subject benchmark statements.

English language modules and assessments on the Pre-Master's Programmes are developed with reference to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

Programme Structure and Features:

The University of the West of England, Bristol's International College Pre-Master's is an 80 credit programme, with each credit equating to 10 notional learning hours, divided into contact and supported self-study time.

A mix of skills-based and specialist subjects are taught, and students are supported towards achieving a range of skills and attributes, via interactions with teaching staff, peers, course materials and assessments.

Where applicable, students are supported in order to develop and utilise specialist skills within their studies. Additionally, self-directed study and high levels of accountability are expected at this level. Assessments require the application of research skills, and the ability to critically evaluate and consolidate new ideas, data and ideas from a broad range of sources.

Pre-Master's students are enrolled on a number of credit-bearing academic subject, study skills and English language modules, as well as non-credit-bearing developmental language and skills module
